The following report outlines grounds maintenance and agronomic services performed at FishHawk Community Development District for the month of **January 2011**

### Grounds maintenance—Turf Mowing Services:

**January :** Mowed all commons two times.

Edged all beds, sidewalks and curbs, at the time of each mowing.

Removed all trash and debris .

Swept all sidewalks, roadways, parking lots, at the time of each mowing.

Mowed teco power lines.

Trail system detailed trails removed trash and debris, swept sidewalks. Cut back vegetation along trail sidewalks, as needed.

Common area Retention ponds completed mowing for the month.

### Grounds maintenance—Detail of site :

Hand pulled weeds and sprayed with selective herbicide.

Sprayed weeds along curbs and sidewalks.

Parksquare detailed trimmed and removed weeds.

Ligustrum Trees trimmed and shaped.

Ornamental Grass started winter cut backs of all grasses.

During the period of January 03,2011 to January 13th ,1011 the following horticultural treatments were applied to the common grounds of FishHawk:

- Post emergent Herbicide treatment was applied to all St. Augustine turf areas
- Bermuda Turf areas at Palmetto club were treated with Green pain to improve appearance for social events.
- Systemic fungicide and liquid fertilizer was applied to all Petunia Beds to prevent disease and increase blooms.
- Fungicide application via Deep Root and drench treatment was applied to Med Jool Palms located at Palmetto Club.
- Soil sample was taken from Chapman Crossings and sent to the lab for analysis and report was created after results were received regarding soil condition affecting Palm, trees and shrubs that were planted on this property.
- Root sample was obtained from Cypress Trees located in Avocet. Report shows that Root rot issued caused by two pathogens. Fungicide treatments will continue to remaining trees.
- Shrubs were treated with Insecticide and fungicide as needed.
