The following report outlines grounds maintenance and agronomic services performed at FishHawk Community Development District for the month of **February 2011**

Grounds maintenance—Turf Mowing Services:

February: Mowed all commons two times.

Edged all beds, sidewalks and curbs, at the time of each mowing.

Removed all trash and debris .

Swept all sidewalks, roadways, parking lots, at the time of each mowing.

Mowed teco power lines.

Trail system detailed trails removed trash and debris, swept sidewalks. Cut back vegetation along trail sidewalks, as needed.

Common area Retention ponds completed mowing for the month.

Grounds maintenance—Detail of site :

Hand pulled weeds and sprayed with selective herbicide.

Sprayed weeds along curbs and sidewalks.

Parksquare detailed trimmed and removed weeds.

Ligustrum Trees trimmed and shaped.

CDD1 main entry along Osprey Ridge cleaned up natural areas. trimmed plants and removed weeds.

Aquatic Center detailed all areas.

Parkset detailed area.

Palmetto Club detailed area.

Osprey Club detailed area.

Starling Water detailed area, and cut back plants at main entry .

Community Circle islands detailed hand pulled weeds.

Crape Myrtles completed winter prune.

Natural area clean up : completed trimming of vegetation along common natural areas.

CDD1 Swim club removed weeds and trimmed shrubs.

CDD1 Detailed main entry .

Cut back all frost damaged plants and shrubs, through out CDD1 and CDD2.

Cleaned up all common areas after storm events.

Palm Trees trimmed all palms, through out CDD1 and CDD2.

Avocet removed dead evergreen tree.

During the period February 07,2011 to February, 15th ,1011 the following horticultural treatments were applied to the common grounds of FishHawk:

- Post emergent Herbicide treatment was applied to all St. Augustine turf areas
- All Bermuda turf areas including Park square were treated several times with liquid fertilizer and pre-emergent herbicide.
- Systemic fungicide and liquid fertilizer was applied to all Petunia Beds
- Cypress Trees located in Avocet and Palmetto Club were treated with fungicide. Treatments will continue to protect these trees.
- Shrubs were treated with Insecticide and fungicide as needed
