## Landscape Maintenance Service Report

The following report outlines grounds maintenance and agronomic services performed at FishHawk Community Development District for the month of **April 2011**

### Grounds maintenance—Turf Mowing Services:

**April:** Mowed all commons weekly.

Edged all beds, sidewalks and curbs, at the time of each mowing.

Removed all trash and debris .

Swept all sidewalks, roadways, parking lots, at the time of each mowing.

Mowed teco power lines, monthly

Trail system detailed trails removed trash and debris, swept sidewalks. Cut back vegetation along trail sidewalks, as needed for the month.

Common area Retention ponds completed mowing for the month.

Completed quarterly mowing of retention ponds.

### Grounds maintenance—Detail of site :

Hand pulled weeds and sprayed with selective herbicide.

Sprayed weeds along curbs and sidewalks.

Park Square detailed trimmed and removed weeds.

Ligustrum Trees trimmed and shaped.

CDD1 detailed front entry and teco power line beds.

Aquatic Center detailed all areas

Palmetto Club detailed area.

Osprey Club cleaned up berm along backside of site.

Starling detailed all bed areas.

Community Circle islands detailed hand pulled weeds.

FishHawk Creek school detailed area.

Colleen Bevis school detailed area.

CDD1 hard edge and sprayed weeds in clay areas of baseball fields.

Ibis Park detailed area.

Removed storm debris from rain event.

Removed annuals through site prep and graded annual beds. Installed new potting mix and fertilizer.

During the period of April 08,2011 to April 15, 2011 the following horticultural treatments were applied to the common grounds of FishHawk:

- Post emergent Herbicide treatment was applied to all St. Augustine turf areas
- Bermuda Turf areas located in Palmetto Club, Park Square and Osprey Club were treated with granular fertilizer and post emergent herbicide
- Systemic fungicide and liquid fertilizer was applied to recently installed annuals throughout the community.
- Deep Root and drench fungicide treatment was applied to Med Jool Palms located at Palmetto Club. Two of these Palms are rapidly declining due to a Root Rot disease .
- Shrubs and trees were treated with systemic fungicide and insecticide as needed.
- All Magnolia Trees located in common grounds were treated with systemic insecticide.
- Annual beds were treated with fungicide and liquid fertilizer.
