The following report outlines grounds maintenance and agronomic services performed at FishHawk Community Development District for the month of **September**

Grounds maintenance—Turf Mowing Services:

September : Mowed all commons four times.

Edged all beds, sidewalks and curbs, at the time of each mowing.

Removed all trash and debris .

Swept all sidewalks, roadways, parking lots, at the time of each mowing.

Mowed teco power lines, for the month.

Trail system detailed trails removed trash and debris, swept sidewalks. Cut back vegetation along trail sidewalks, as needed.

Common area Retention ponds completed mowing for the month.

Grounds maintenance—Detail of site :

Hand pulled weeds and sprayed with selective herbicide.

During the period of 09/01/2011-09/11/11 the following Horticultural treatments were applied:

1. Floratam dry areas located in common grounds were spot treated with Insecticide Arena to prevent Chinch Bugs.
2. Acidic Granular fertilizer was applied again to all Azaleas locate in front of Publix by retail area.
3. Follow up treatment consisting of systemic fungicide was applied via deep rot injection and bud drench to remaining MedJool Palms located at Palmetto Club.
4. Magnolia trees were treated to control Scale insects and Sooty Mold.
5. Floratam areas in common grounds were treated with post-emergent herbicide to control turf weeds
6. All Bermuda grass included baseball field in FishHawk CDD 1 were treated with fertilizer and post emergent herbicide.
