Landscape Maintenance Service Report

The following report outlines grounds maintenance and agronomic services performed at FishHawk Community Development District for the month of **November 2009**

Grounds maintenance—Turf Mowing Services

Service Date Service Description

11-2, 11-16 & 11-30-09 :Mowed, edged line-trimmed, and swept all sidewalks roads parking lots at the time of mowing. Removed al trash and debris was gathered at time of mowing.

11-23: Mowed common area retention ponds.

11-19 : Mowed Teco power line fields.

11-9 ; Mowed trail system

10-26: Detailed trails cut backs along sidewalks and sprayed weeds.

Grounds maintenance—Detail of site :

Hand pulled and used selective herbicide to control weeds in mulched beds.

Sprayed pavement weeds through the common areas.

Trimmed and shaped Ligustrum trees.

Crape Myrtles suckers were removed through the site.

Aquatic Center trimmed and removed weeds.

Parksquare trimmed and removed weeds.

Osprey Club trimmed and removed weeds.

Palmetto Club trimmed and removed all weeds.

Hawk Park trimmed and removed weeds.

Community Circle islands trimmed and removed weeds.

Landscape up grades completed:

Installed new flowering annuals for the winter months.

6303 Bridgecrest removed dead pine tree in natural area.

Bridgecrossing Dr. removed dead oak trees in natural area.

Agronomic Services :

Floratam turf areas were treated with systemic fungicide to control recurrent take all— root rot disease

Post emergent herbicide was applied to control boardleaf weeds.

Liquid fertilizer 20-20-20 was applied to all trees and shrubs.

Aquatic Center turf was treated with fertilizer to help recover do to water stress.

Insecticide and fungicide was applied to shrubs and trees as needed.

All Bermuda turf was treated Ammonium Sulfate and post emergent herbicide.

All annuals beds were drenched with fungicide for new annuals.
