Landscape Maintenance Service Report

The following report outlines grounds maintenance and agronomic services performed at FishHawk Community Development District for the month of **November**

Grounds maintenance—Turf Mowing Services:

November: Mowed all commons (2) two times.

Edged all beds, sidewalks and curbs, at the time of each mowing.

Removed all trash and debris .

Swept all sidewalks, roadways, parking lots, at the time of each mowing.

Mowed teco power lines, for the month.

Trail system detailed trails removed trash and debris, swept sidewalks. Cut back vegetation along trail sidewalks, as needed.

Common area Retention ponds completed monthly mowing.

Grounds maintenance—Detail of site :

Hand pulled weeds and sprayed with selective herbicide.

Sprayed weeds along curbs and sidewalks.

Parksquare detailed trimmed and removed weeds.

Ligustrum Trees trimmed and shaped.

Natural areas sprayed vegetation along edge of all common areas.

Aquatic Center detailed all areas.

Parkset detailed parks.

Palmetto Club detailed area.

Starling Water detailed area.

Community Circle islands detailed areas.

Annual Beds: removed existing annuals, prepped beds added new soil and fertilizer for new plants.

CDD1 Swim club removed weeds and trimmed shrubs.

CDD1 Detailed main entry .

Colleen Bevis school trimmed shrubs as needed.

Ibis park cut back natural area around park.

FishHawk Creek school detailed all areas.

During the period of 11/01/11 to 11/11/11 the following treatments were applied to the common grounds of FishHawk:

- A systemic fungicide application was applied to the turf located in the common grounds to control Take All Root Rot disease as needed.
- Post Emergent Herbicide application was applied to turf located in the common grounds including Bermuda grass areas located in Palmetto Club, Park square and Osprey Club to control broadleaf weeds and sedges.
- All areas where annuals are to be planted were treated with a soil fungicide previous to annual installation.
- Trees and Shrubs were treated with systemic fungicide and Insecticide as needed.
- Baseball Field located in FishHawk I was treated with fertilizer and systemic fungicide.
