

**ADA CHANGES BRING MODIFICATIONS TO
FISHHAWK RANCH COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT
AMENITIES AND FACILITIES**

The U. S. Department of Justice recently adopted several amendments to the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), which will necessitate some modifications to existing Fishhawk Ranch Community Development District amenities and facilities. The new regulations were adopted by the Department of Justice on March 15, 2011 and all modifications must be in place by March 15, 2012.

The most noticeable changes you will see include:

- ADA Chair lifts being added to District owned pools where required.
- Reconfiguration or relocation of fitness center equipment to meet the requirement for additional space between certain machines.
- Minor modifications to playgrounds and sports fields where necessary to meet various requirements.

Fishhawk Community Development District and Fishhawk Community Development District II have been working with various consultants since last year, inspecting all facilities and identifying all areas that require modification to ensure compliance with the new regulations by March 15, 2012. All work associated with the project will be funded by the Community Development District(s).
